

#### Introduction

Every year, the Squamish Nation develops a budget to align resource allocation with upcoming strategic priorities. From programs and events, to capital projects, to staffing costs, the budget outlines all resources required by the Squamish Nation to provide programs and services to their members and to invest in their future.

Now, in the second year of their budget transformation, the Nation has undertaken a number of key planning initiatives to ensure that their budget enables them to improve programs and services and to take meaningful steps towards their strategic objectives. Planning for these budgets began last year with the approval of the Nation's 2020-2023 Strategic Plan.

This year, from February 23 to March 7, 2021, the Squamish Nation used a budget engagement to gather public feedback on various initiatives identified as priorities in their annual budget. The purpose of this program was to gather feedback from all members both on and off-reserve, including Elders, youth, and advisory committees.

- The process educated members on the Nation's various initiatives and priorities, and asked them to provide feedback
- Ethelo used the results to generate a particular set of funding changes that are predicted to have the most community support.

## **Key Findings**

### **Priority Initiatives Budget Overview**

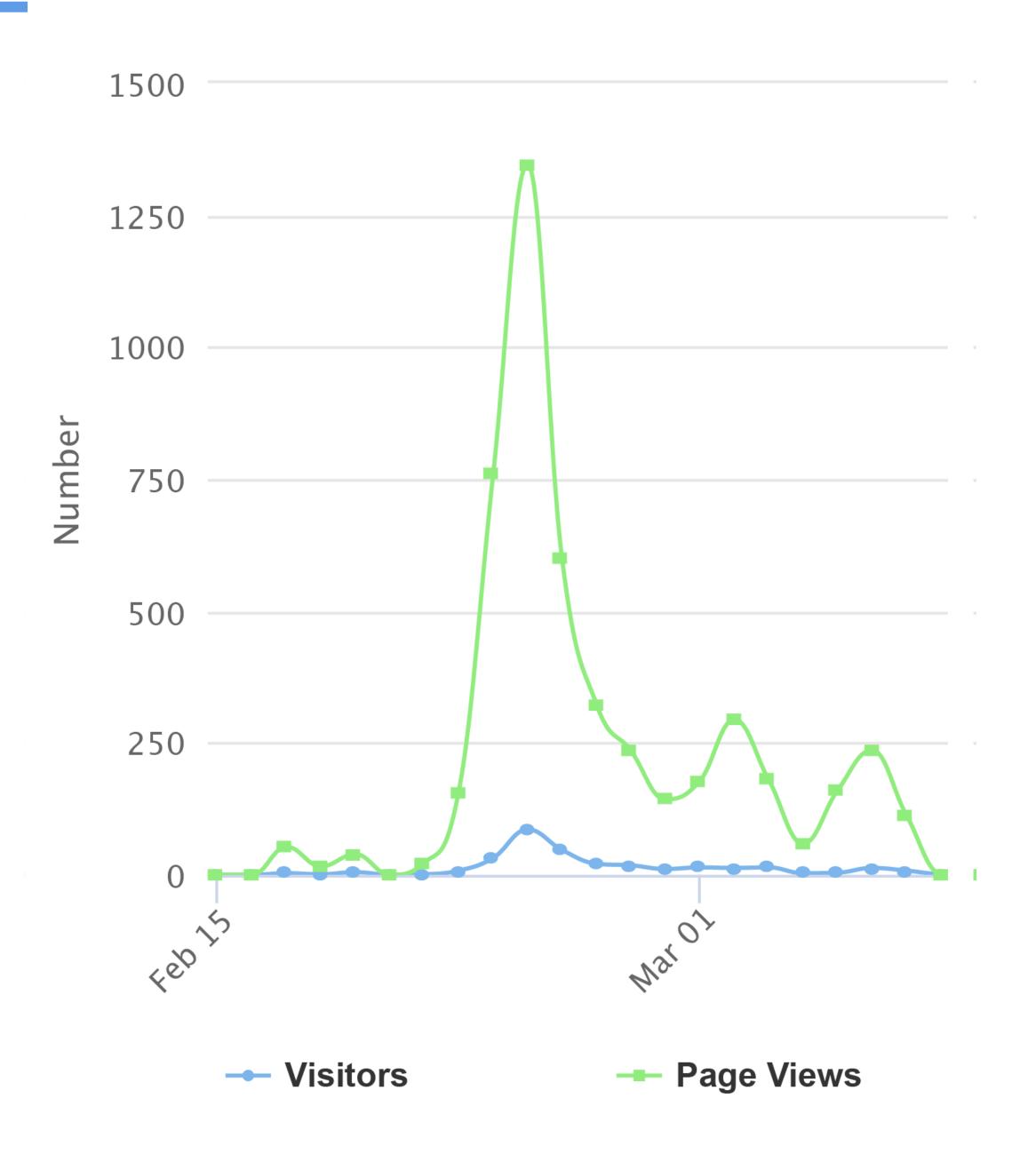

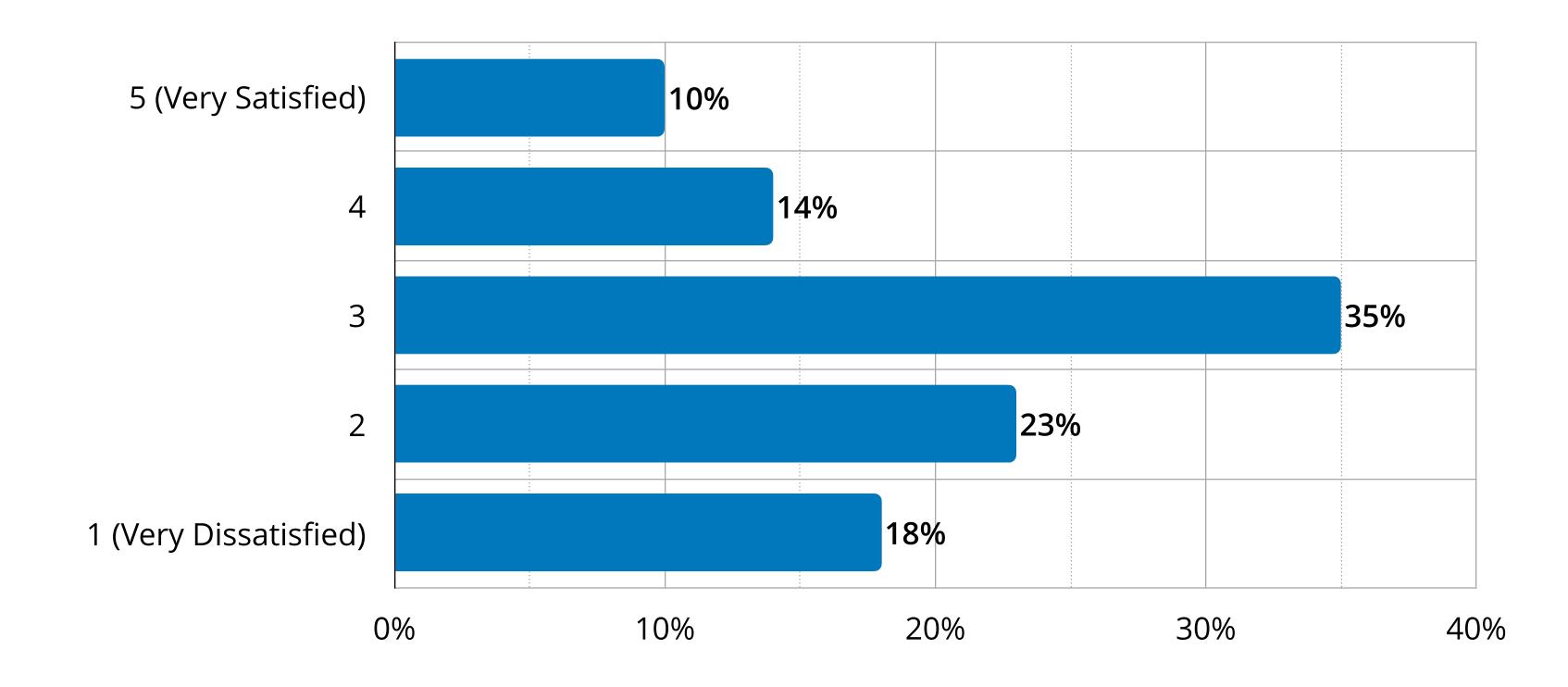

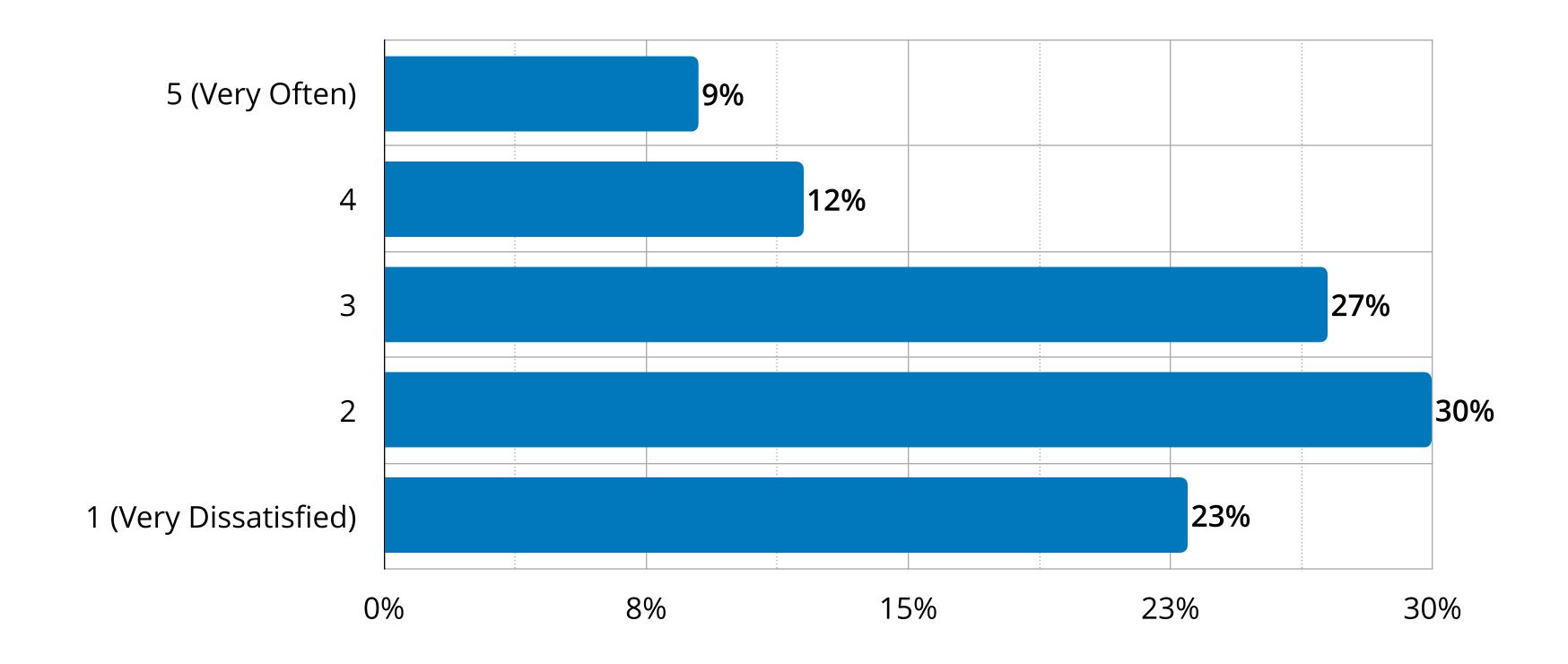
#### **Overall Satisfaction**

How often do you (and/or your under-aged children, if applicable) access the programs and services offered by the Squamish Nation?



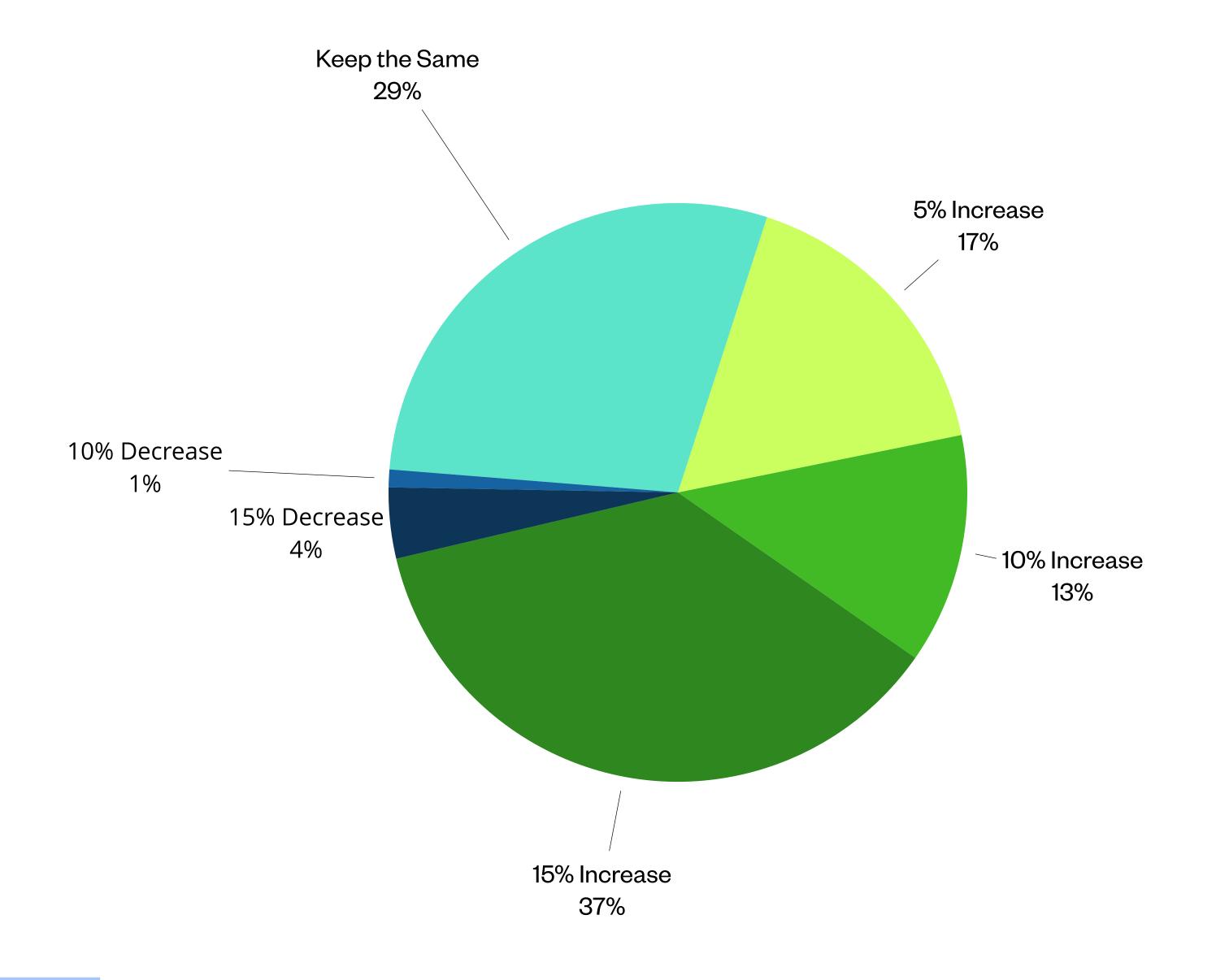

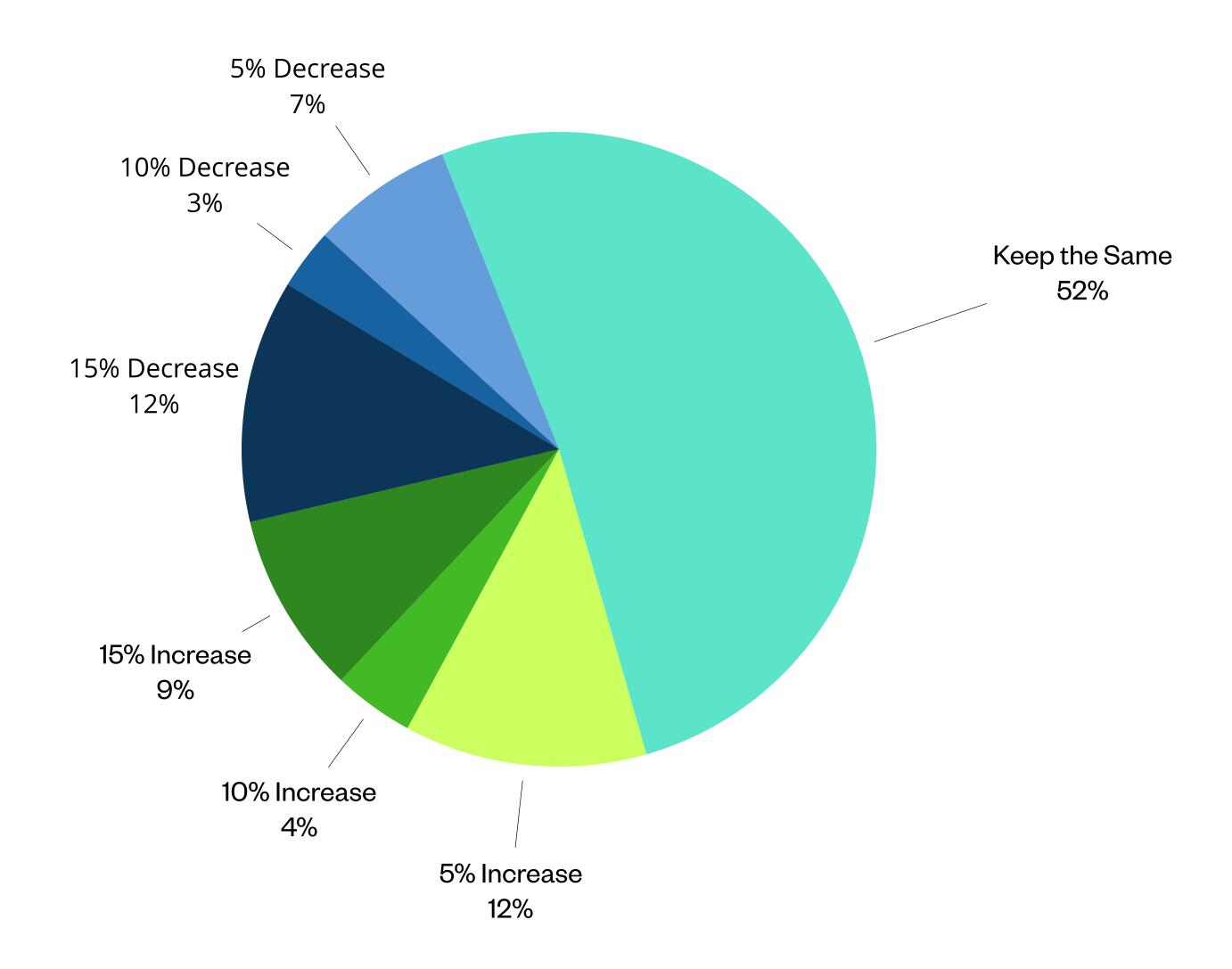

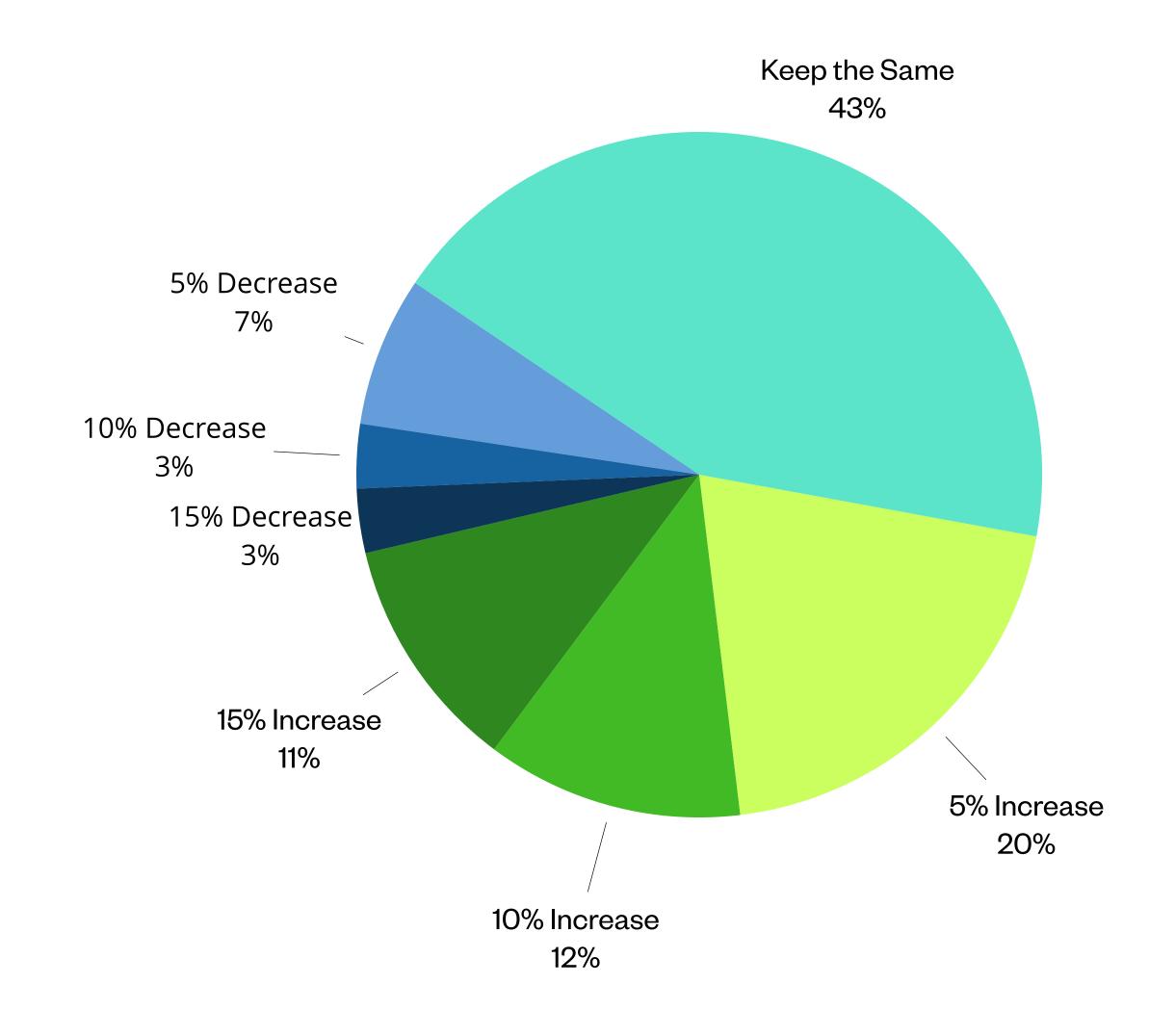

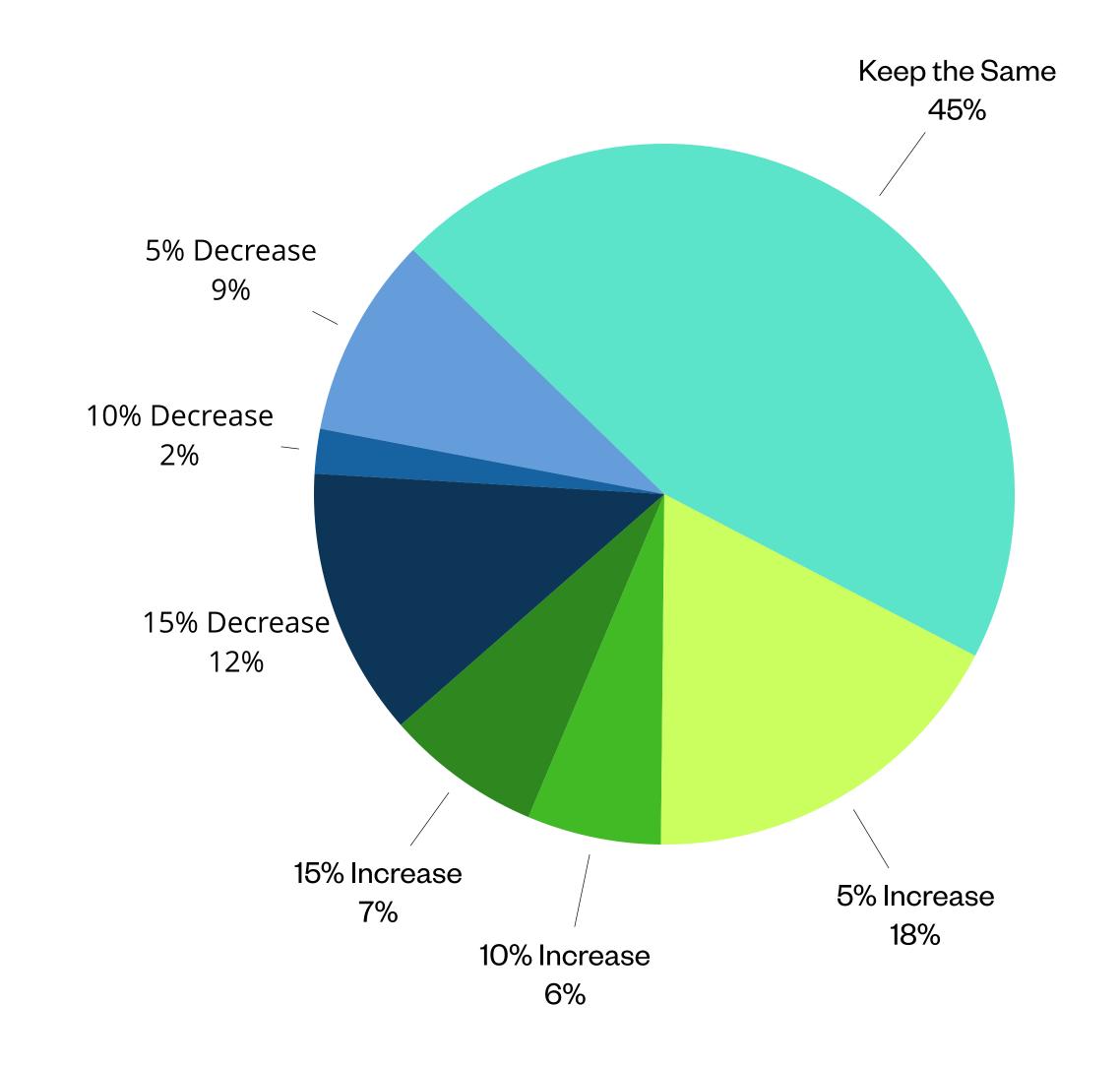

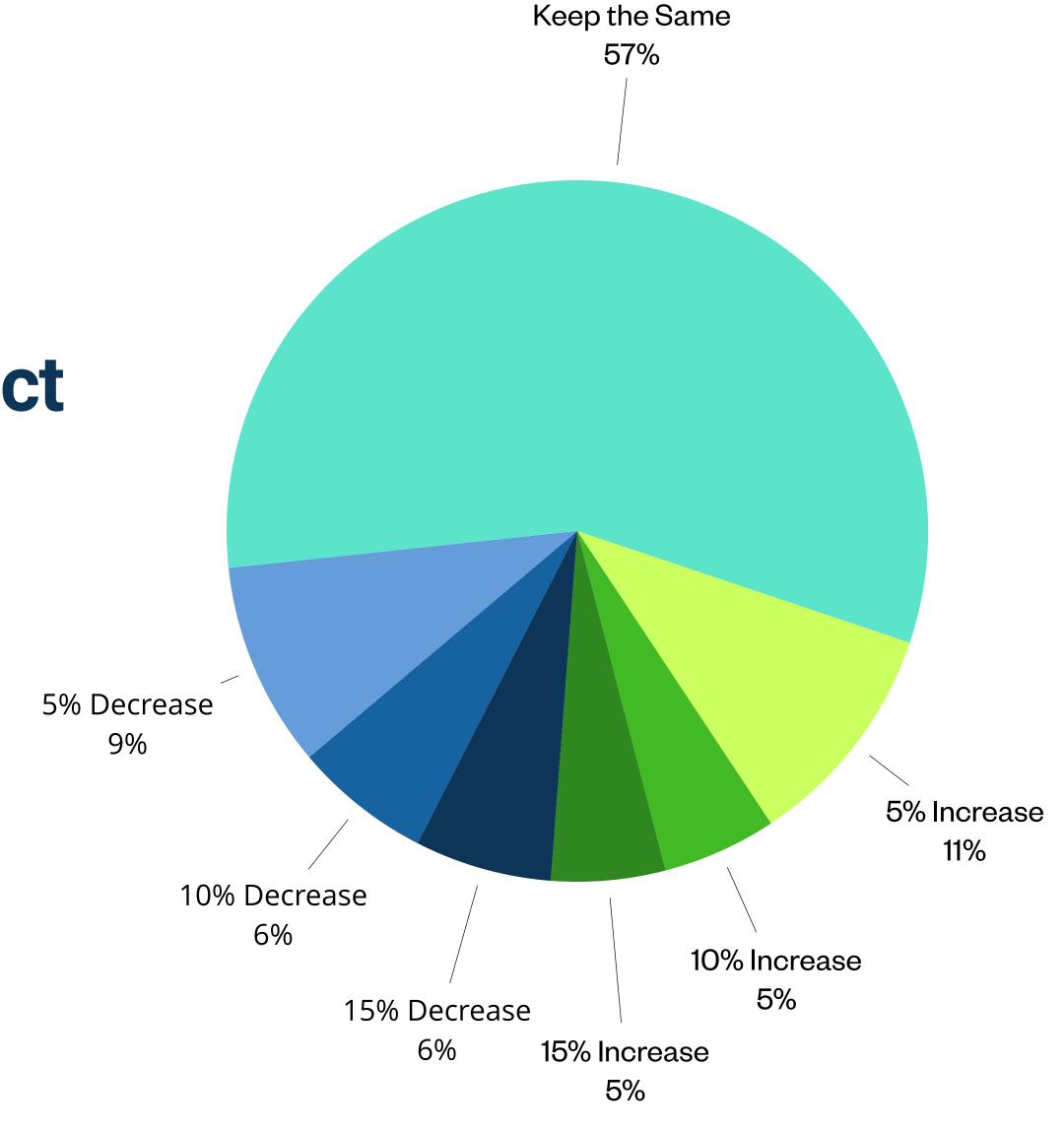

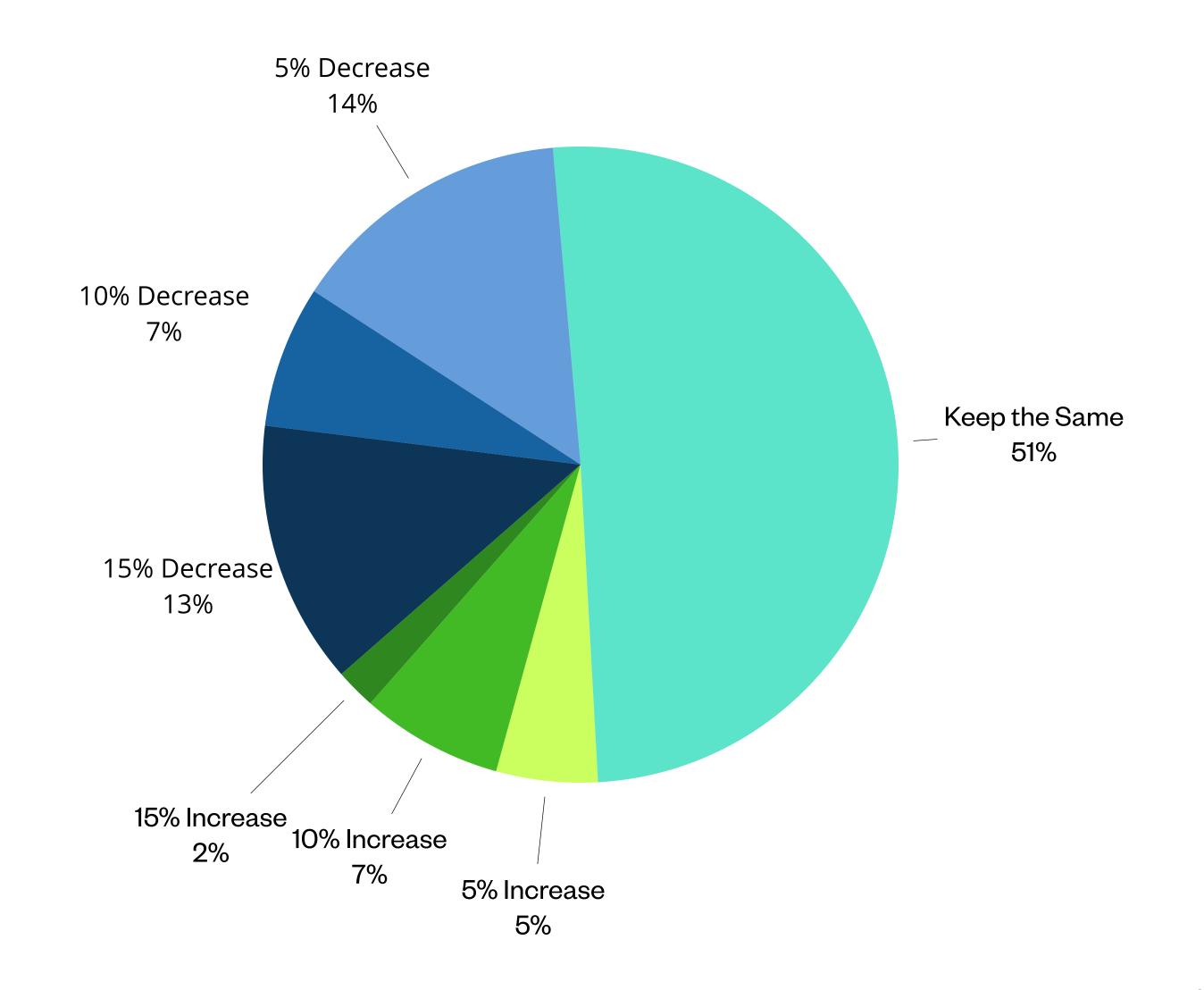

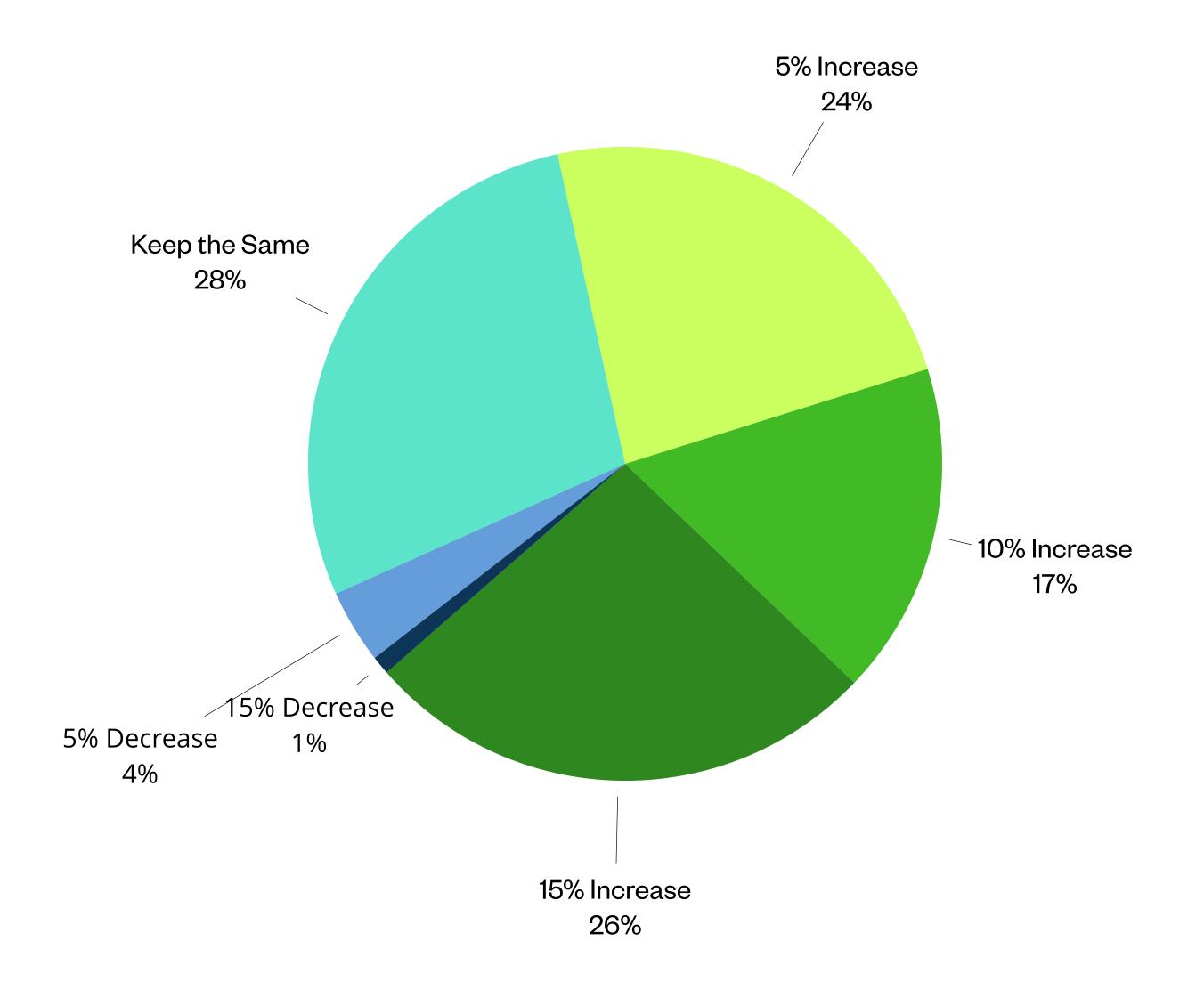

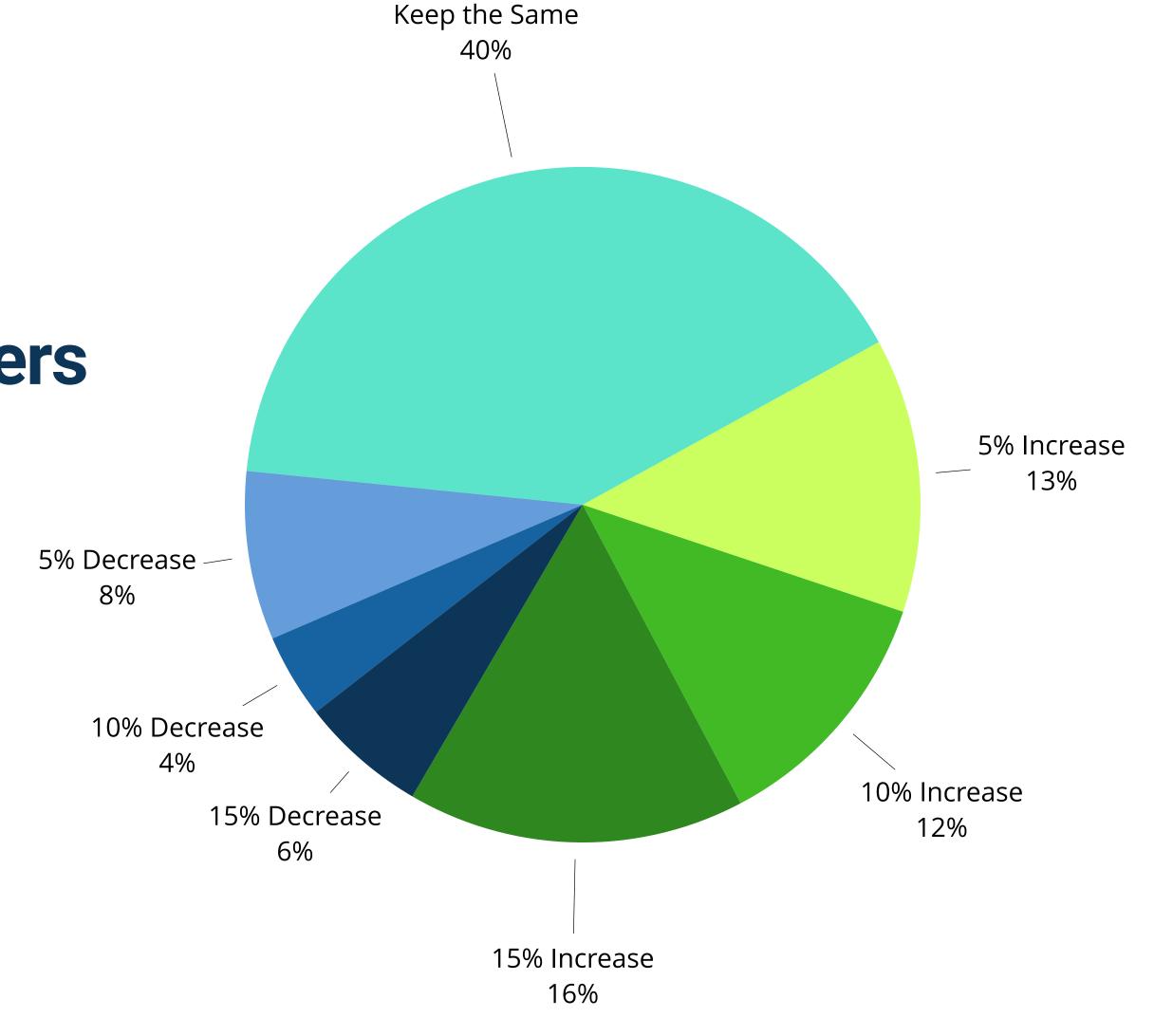
